Gustavus Loomis, 5th Infty under the Act of Congress at Fort Brooke Fla (the place of general rendezvous) on the 9th day of March 1858, to serve for the term of six months, from the date of enrollment, unless sooner discharged; from the 9th day of March 1858 (when enrolled) to the 11th day of May 1858. The Company was organized by Capt. Mickler at St. Augustine, in the month of March 1858, and marched thence to Fort Brooke Fla where it arrived the 9th of March, a distance of one hundred ninety three miles.
